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Candidates registering for the RPL programme and for each qualification will have a choice of specializations (chose only 1 specialization) as follows:

- Short-Term
- Health
- Statutory (applies only to Claims Assessor)*

Important Notes:

- Candidates whose expression letters are received by closing date and have been successfully evaluated will be invited by the SDP for further screening.
- Successful candidates registered for the RPL program will be certificated by the Quality Council for Trades & Occupations (QCTO) after successfully passing the compulsory External Integrated Summative Assessment (EISA) examination. EISA is a centralised, formal and supervised examination.
- The implementation of the program is expected to start in November 2022 and end in April 2023. This is an INSETA funded program – candidates will **NOT** be expected to pay any fees to the SDP to participate in the RPL program.
- Other details regarding the program will be shared with approved candidates during a precommencement orientation. The SDP will facilitate the orientation.
