- 3. No TVET College will be considered for funding outside the funding process
- 4. INSETA will provide an administration fee to the applicant TVET Colleges where applicable
- 5. INSETA will not fund Work Integrated Learning and Skills Programme for Unemploγed Youth that the TVET College commences before both parties have signed the Memorandum of Agreement.
- 6. Previous track record for SETA funded training will be considered during the evaluation process of the application submitted
