PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Only Public TVET Colleges are eligible to apply (No applications directly from learners to INSETA will be considered)
- 2. TVET Colleges will be approved only subject to their compliance with the criteria set and the availability of funds; as INSETA would like to reach all provinces with the funded projects.
- 3. No TVET College will be considered for funding outside the funding process.
- 4. INSETA will provide an administration fee to the applicant TVET Colleges where applicable.
- 5. INSETA will not fund any programme/s that the TVET College commences before both parties have signed the Memorandum of Agreement.
- 6. Previous track record for SETA funded programme will be considered during the evaluation process of the application submitted.

No late application submissions will be considered.
