**RE: INSETA COMMUNIQUE - THE INSETA SUSPENDS ALL CUSTOMER WALK-IN SERVICES AS A COVID-19 PREVENTATIVE MEASURE**

Dear INSETA Stakeholders

With, effect from Friday, 20 March 2020, the Inseta will close its reception and suspend all customer walk-in services. As such from this date, no walk-in submissions, applications, and enquiries will be accepted.

All applications and submissions of supporting documentation should be made online or be submitted to the relevant department via the emails listed below. All queries should be directed telephonically, or via emails.

**HARD COPY /TENDER APPLICATIONS**

All Tenders and applications that require hard copy drop offs or certified hard copies must be deposited in the submissions box at the INSETA reception desk between 9am and 5pm only. However, these will be attended to only after the prescribed document-quarantine period of 24 hours.

**PROTOCOL ON DOCUMENT COLLECTION & DROP-OFF**

- No one will be allowed into INSETA offices without a scheduled appointment (appointments must be requested and confirmed via email).
- All persons wishing to drop-off or collect documents at the offices of the INSETA should ensure that they do not present any of the symptoms associated with the coronavirus and other respiratory illnesses.
- All persons entering the INSETA offices will be expected to apply a disinfectant to their hands prior to being granted entry.
- While within the INSETA offices all persons are expected to exercise good hygiene and social distancing (wherever possible, distance between any two persons should be at least 1,5 metres).
