

## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) to Employers for the Rural Learnership Funding

**INSETA hereby notifies all INSETA Registered Employers (levy and non-levy paying) that the application window is now open for funding of Rural Learnership in the following provinces:**

- Northern Cape
- North West
- Mpumalanga
- Free State

The application window for 2021/22 Financial Year is now open from **15<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and applications will be accepted until 31<sup>st</sup> May 2021.**

**Please Note:**

1. Only South African Public TVET Colleges are eligible to apply on behalf of learners. INSETA will not consider any applications coming directly from learners.
2. TVET Colleges will be approved only subject to their compliance with the criteria set and the availability of funds; as INSETA would like to reach all provinces with the funded projects.
3. Only Learnership that are addressing insurance-related Critical Scarce Skills and Occupations in high demand will be considered. (For the list, refer to [www.inseta.org.za](http://www.inseta.org.za))
4. No TVET College will be considered for funding outside the funding application process.
5. INSETA will not fund any programme(s) that the TVET College commences before both parties have signed the Memorandum of Agreement and before the TVET submits the required learner documents to INSETA.
6. The TVET's track record for the implementation of previous SETA-funded programme will be considered (for those not applying for the first time) during the evaluation process of the application submitted.
