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EXTENSION OF DG FUNDING WINDOW - 2022/2023

INSETA hereby notifies all companies in the Insurance and related services sector and registered with INSETA, to apply for support in the areas of Learnerships, Internships, Bursaries for Workers, Candidacy, Adult Education and Training, Skills Programmes Unemployed Youth and Workers, Bursaries for TVET College Lecturers, Recognition for Prior Learning (RPL), Short Skills Training for CET College Managers and Strategic Projects.

The application window currently open for 2022/23 Discretionary Grant applications <u>will be extended</u>. <u>to 13 April 2022.</u>

Kindly note that applications will only be accepted at the INSETA's discretion and subject to the following:

- 1. Only companies whose core business falls within the INSETA scope may apply
- 2. Applicant companies must have submitted a WSP and ATR for the 2022/23 financial year
- 3. All applications must be made online **ONLY**. The link will be available on the INSETA website <u>www.inseta.org.za</u> from 20 January 2022. Please use the system user manual attached for guidance on application submission first-come-first-served basis
- 4. Allocations will be made subject to funding availability
- 5. Applicant companies must be able to commence programmes no later than 02 February 2023/
- 6. First time applicants will be subject to site visit and if approved, will be awarded conservative numbers until track record is established
- 7. Previous track record for successful implementation of INSETA-funded learning programmes will be considered in funding allocation
- 8. Capacity to deliver the training and/or host the learners will be verified by INSETA prior to awarding funding
- 9. Failure to submit documentation or to commence within the stipulated timelines will result in the withdrawal of funding
- 10. Employers may only apply for funding for learners on ONLY ONE of the learning programmes listed below in a financial year.
