2. TVET Colleges may apply for unemployed youth (between ages of 18-35).
3. Applications for funded Learnerships must be for programmes meeting the INSETA scarce and critical skills list and the needs of the insurance sector (See the INSETA website www.inseta.org.za).
4. The Public TVET College must be accredited or have an extension of scope for the learnership they are applying for.
5. Public TVET College will be approved only subject to their compliance with the criteria set and the availability of funds as INSETA would like to reach all provinces with the funded projects.
6. No Public TVET College will be considered for funding outside the funding process.
7. Programmes may only start once the applicant TVET college has received approval from INSETA and after submission of all required documentation to INSETA

(Programme2) The TVET College may appoint an Accredited Skills Development Provider to offer any of the above-mentioned skills programmes or utilize their own accreditation/the INSETA Registered Skills Development Provider must be accredited (unless implementing a non-accredited programme) aligned to Critical and Scarce Skills.
TVET College and INSETA Registered Skills Development Provider applications will be approved
3. subject to their compliance with the above-mentioned requirements.
