Section H: Criteria

How are bursaries awarded?

- > Bursaries are awarded according to academic merit, financial need/affordability of applicants.
- > Employed applicants are awarded on a sliding scale.
- > Bursary funds are paid out directly to tertiary institutions and other relevant service providers bursary fund monies are ONLY paid out directly to students under exceptional circumstances.
- New and continuing students
- Final selections are made by the ISSF BURSARY.

Who is eligible for a ISSF Bursary?

- This category is only open to the South African Public (Unemployed and Employed) in cross sectoral studies. South learners between the ages of 18-35 who are unemployed are encouraged to apply. Priority will be granted to courses in the Insurance and related sectors.
- Unemployed Youth (Between the ages of 18-35)
- Employed
- > Only applicants who intend to study or who are already studying for a qualification at a tertiary Institution, which is registered and accredited with the Council for Higher Education (CHE).
