EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) to Employers for the Rural Learnership Programme

INSETA hereby notifies all INSETA Registered Employers (levy and non-levy paying) that the application window is now open for funding of Rural Learnership in the following provinces:

- **Northern Cape**
- **North West**
- **Mpumalanga**
- **Free State**

The application window for 2023/24 Financial Year is now open from 18th September 2023 and applications will be accepted until 13th October2023.

Please Note:

- 1. Only INSETA registered employers (levy and non-levy paying) are eligible to apply (No applications directly from learners to INSETA will be considered)
- 2. Employers will be approved only subject to their compliance with the criteria set and the availability of funds as INSETA would like to reach the stated provinces with these funded learnerships.
- 3. Only learners who reside in the rural areas of the above-mentioned provinces.
- 4. Only Learnerships that are addressing the Seta Critical Scarce Skills and Occupations that are on high demand (refer to www.inseta.org.za) will be considered.
- 5. Employer must be willing to progress the learner to the internship programme on completion of the learnership (subject to the learner deem to be competent and having an interest to remain in the insurance
- 6. No Employer will be considered for funding outside the funding process.
- 7. INSETA will not fund any programme/s that the Employer commences before the approval of the application.
- Previous track record for SETA funded programme will be considered (for those not applying for the first time) during the evaluation process of the application submitted.
