- 1. Only INSETA Accredited and Registered SDPs with the capacity to provide registered Facilitators, Assessor's and Moderators will be considered.
- 2. SDP must recruit 20 Lecturers from Free State TVET Colleges to participate in the Programme.
- 3. The SDP must confirm three Industry Experts to Present in the Insurance Capacitation Day.
- 4. The SDP is required to Book a Training Venue that will accommodate and cater for the Beneficiaries. (Venue must be in Kroonstad)
- 5. No other SDP applications for services will be considered for funding outside this process.
- 6. This learning programme will comprise of the following unit standards from the Further Education and Training Certificate: Short Term Insurance, NQF Level 4, and SAQA ID 49929. The full credit value of this programme is 32 credits
