THE PUBLIC HIGHER EEDUCATION INSTITUTIONS

- The Public Higher Education Institution must be South African, accredited, PHEI's (Public Universities, University of Technology and Technical Vocational Education and Training College).
- The Public Higher Education Institution found to be non-compliant in the past implementation of INSETA funded programmes will not be considered for funding unless evidence of remediation to the satisfaction of INSETA can be produced.

THE STUDENT MUST

- Have a South African Citizen with a valid identity document.
- Be unemployed with age from 18 to 35 years.
- Register at a recognised Public Higher Education institution studying towards qualifications that are related to the insurance Critical Scarce Skills and as per Bursary Funding advertisement issued by the
- Possess good academic record, having maintained good academic record or higher in their previous year of study.
- Not funded by any other sponsor.
