Notice to Stakeholders (SDPs, Employers & Candidates)

RE: Postponement of 5th April 2024 External Integrated Summative Assessment (EISA) Exams

INSETA is a delegated quality partner of the Qualification Council for Trades & Occupations (QCTO). Among other, the delegated authority includes INSETA assuming the responsibility to manage the implementation of EISAs for all registered Occupational Qualifications that fall under its delegation.


This letter confirms postponement of 5th April 2024 EISA examinations due to reasons provided below:

1. Overlap between approval of results for the EISA exams written on 19th Jan 2023 – the implication may lead to deserving candidates missing a re-write opportunity.
2. The late approval of the QAS Addendum for the Financial Advisor basket of occupational qualifications – the April 2024 EISA must include learners entered for the associated OCs.
3. The delay in developing EISA instruments for the reviewed Insurance Underwriter Occupational Qualification (SAQA ID 117329) - the April 2024 EISA must include learners entered for the associated OC.
4. Provision for other delays as a result of the 2024 Easter Weekend break affecting other logistical preparations (i.e. confirmation of assessment venues, travel etc)
5. Any other

The postponed EISA will thus be written on **25th April 2024** – candidates will receive learner permits confirming the examination logistics. INSETA apologises for the inconvenience caused by this postponement.
