In response to a recent video made by the OUTA regarding the deaccreditation of a specific training provider, INSETA wishes to clarify and refute these claims.

Notably, OUTA's statement is void of the accurate sequence of events and suggests that INSETA's right to follow the legal process should simply be mooted. It is our understanding that this matter is still before the courts and INSETA will be guided by the outcome of the legal proceedings.
