INSETA invites applications for suitably qualified persons representing Organised Employers and Organised Labour within the insurance sector to serve on the INSETA Board. Nominated representatives from the insurance sector in possession of NQF level 7 qualification that have an identifiable interest in skills development should possess knowledge, skills and competencies in the following disciplines

- The application of corporate governance and ethics;
- Skills development legislation and the National Skill Development Plan (NSDP);
- The Public Finance Management Act;
- Financial management;
- Education, training, skills development and human resource development and
- Quality assurance of learning provision.

## Nominations must be submitted in writing and with the following details:

- 1. Full names and address of the person or organization nominating candidate.
- 2. A curriculum vitae of the candidate which include:
  - a. Candidates full name, identity number, gender, disability status and race;
  - b. Contact address, telephone and email address;
  - c. Certified copies of qualifications and ID (certification date stamp not older than 3 months);
  - d. Previous experience and relevant expertise quoting dates and organisations concerned; and
  - e. At least two names and contact details of reference.
- 3. Recommendation letter from the stakeholder constituency.
- 4. Completed nomination form.
- 5. Completed declaration of interest (available on the INSETA website)
- 6. A signed acceptance of Nomination Letter from a candidate (available on the INSETA website)

The term of office will expire on 31 March 2030. Background checks and qualification verifications will be undertaken. No individual or personal nominations should be submitted to INSETA. The nomination must be submitted through the respective and recognised stakeholder constituency
