LEGACY QUALIFICATIONS TRANSITION UPDATE

This memorandum serves to advise the sector on the legacy qualifications transition update.

Insurance Sector Education and Training Authority (INSETA) is a delegated Quality Partner of the Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO) for qualifications covering occupations identified in the Insurance, Risk Management and Pension Funds SIC Codes as identified.

INSETA is pleased to inform its stakeholders that the Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET) has granted a **24-month extension for learner enrolments from the 1st July 2026 to 30 June 2028** on the following legacy qualifications:

This extension provides the sector with an opportunity to continue enrolling learners on the above qualifications during the approved extension period, thereby supporting learner progression and facilitating the completion of skills development initiatives within the insurance and related services sector.

Accreditation of Skills Development Providers / Reregistration of assessors and Moderators

Stakeholders are further advised that **INSETA will not be accepting new accreditation applications** for the above-listed legacy qualifications during the extension period. The legacy qualifications are currently being phased out, stakeholders are encouraged to apply to the QCTO for accreditation for Occupational Qualifications.

In respect of existing accredited Skills Development Providers, requests relating to accreditation status, scope extensions, learner enrolments, and other related matters will be considered on a case-by-case basis. INSETA registered Assessors and Moderators extensions will be considered based on SDP requests that are accompanied by SLA.

INSETA will not adopt a blanket approach in managing accreditation matters associated with these qualifications. Each request will be evaluated on its individual merits, taking into account regulatory requirements, provider performance, learner interests, and sector needs.

Stakeholders are encouraged to engage with INSETA regarding any specific circumstances requiring consideration during this extension period.

Further information and operational guidelines relating to the implementation of the extension will be communicated in due course.

INSETA appreciates the continued support and cooperation of all stakeholders in advancing skills development within the insurance sector.
