

REOPENING OF THE CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE ACCOUNTING AUTHORITY (BOARD) OF THE INSURANCE SECTOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING AUTHORITY (INSETA)

INSETA invites nominations of suitably qualified persons to fill vacancies representing Organised Employers (4), Professional Bodies/Community/Government (1) within the insurance sector on the INSETA Accounting Authority (Board). Nominated representatives from the insurance sector, preferably in possession of an NQF Level 7 qualification and with an identifiable interest in skills development, should possess knowledge, skills, competencies, or the ability to develop capability in one or more of the following areas:

- * Corporate governance and ethics;
- * Skills development legislation and the National Skills Development Plan (NSDP);
- * The Public Finance Management Act (PFMA);
- * Financial management;
- * Education, training, skills development and human resource development; and
- * Quality assurance of learning provision.

Nominations must be submitted in writing and must include the following:

1. A completed nomination form (available on the INSETA website);
2. A signed acceptance of nomination;
3. The full name and address of the person or organisation nominating the candidate;
4. A curriculum vitae of the candidate, including:
 - * Full names, identity number, gender, disability status and race;
 - * Contact address, telephone number and email address;
 - * Previous experience and relevant expertise, including dates and organisations concerned; and
 - * At least two references, including contact details;
5. Certified copies of qualifications and identity document (certification date not older than three months); and
6. A completed declaration of interest form (available on the INSETA website).

No individual or personal nominations will be considered. All nominations must be submitted through the relevant sector stakeholder constituency. As this constitutes a new nomination process, all interested candidates are required to submit a fresh nomination together with the prescribed supporting documentation, irrespective of whether they were nominated in response to any previous advertisement. Nominations submitted during previous processes will not be considered for purposes of this process.

Nominations, together with the required supporting documentation, must be submitted to the Acting Chief Executive Officer via email at boardnominations@inseta.org.za no later than 17h00 on 24 July 2026.
