The Insurance Sector Education and Training Authority (INSETA) invites suitably qualified and experienced individuals to express their interest in participating in the INSETA-funded Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Programme for the occupational qualifications listed below.

This initiative is aimed at candidates who have acquired relevant knowledge, skills, and workplace experience through informal, non-formal, or work-based learning but do not yet hold a formal occupational qualification. Through the RPL process, eligible candidates will have the opportunity to have their existing competencies assessed and, where successful, obtain a nationally recognised occupational qualification.

The programme will be implemented by QCTO-accredited and INSETA-aligned Skills Development Providers (SDPs) in accordance with the relevant Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO) policies and requirements.

Application Process

Prospective applicants who wish to be considered for participation in the RPL programme are required to submit a signed one-page Expression of Interest (EOI) to one of the Skills Development Providers (SDPs) listed below.

The submitted Expression of Interest will be assessed by the selected SDP as part of the recruitment and selection process. The EOI must contain the following information:

1. Full name(s) and surname of the applicant.
2. South African Identity number or Passport number (where applicable).
3. Current employment details, including the employer's name, job title/position, and total years of relevant work experience.
4. Province in which the applicant is currently based.
5. The occupational qualification for which the applicant is applying, as indicated in the table above.

The closing date for the submission of Expressions of Interest (EOIs) is 31 July 2026. Late submissions will not be considered.

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Specialisations:

Candidates applying for the Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Programme in the Insurance Underwriter and Claims Assessor occupational qualifications must indicate their chosen area of specialisation as part of the application process.

Important Information:

- Only applicants whose Expressions of Interest (EOIs) are received on or before the closing date and who successfully meet the initial evaluation criteria will be invited by the selected Skills Development Provider (SDP) to participate in the next stage of the screening and selection process.
- Candidates who are successfully admitted to the Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Programme and who successfully complete the compulsory External Integrated Summative Assessment (EISA) and deemed competent will be awarded the relevant occupational qualification certificate by the Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO). The EISA is a nationally standardised, externally administered, and supervised assessment.
- The programme is scheduled to commence on the 1st August 2026 and conclude on the 31st March 2027. Participation in this RPL programme is fully funded by the INSETA. Accordingly, successful candidates will not be required to pay any tuition, assessment, or programme participation fees to the appointed Skills Development Provider.
- Additional information relating to the programme, including implementation arrangements, assessment requirements, and participant expectations, will be communicated to successful candidates during a compulsory pre-programme orientation session facilitated by the appointed Skills Development Provider.

INSETA has delegated the recruitment, selection, and implementation of the Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Programme to the appointed Skills Development Providers (SDPs). Accordingly, all enquiries and communication relating to the recruitment and selection process should be directed to the relevant SDP.

INSETA will not engage directly with applicants or learners during the implementation of the processes outlined in this communication.
